- A certified copy of your diploma and final grades** (signed and stamped by the appropriate authority such as your school). If you still need to sit your final exams, you can send us your grade lists over the past years. Note that for final enrolment you still have to send us a certified copy as soon as you pass your exams. Note: Chinese students also need to submit a NESO certificate: www.nesochina.org
- A copy of your (*valid*) **passport**
- Certified copies of your birth certificate and its English translation (certified translator)**
- Five passport-size photos** (4.5cm x 3.5cm). The photo should have a white or light grey background.
- Résumé/Curriculum Vitae** (in English). Not needed for Pre-IBMS students.
- Students who already live in the Netherlands** also have to send a copy of a valid residence permit which proves they are entitled to stay in the Netherlands, a copy of address registration in the Netherlands (GBA form or copy of your housing contract) and a statement concerning all previous education since arrival in the Netherlands. Please enclose your transcript and send a proof of enrolment of the school you are studying at this moment.
- Sufficient IELTS/TOEFL IBT** score (for the programme you apply for).
Not required for students who graduated from IBMS/ IBL programmes in the Netherlands. And not required for students whom previous education was taught in English.
IELTS: International English Language Testing System - Organised by British Council - www.ielts.org
** The IELTS test, Academic Band, consists of 4 parts: writing, reading, listening and speaking. All scores should be equal to the overall band score, with the exception of 1 (one score can be 0.5 points less than the overall band score).*
TOEFL: Test of English as a Foreign Language - Organised by the ETS in the USA - www.toefl.org
